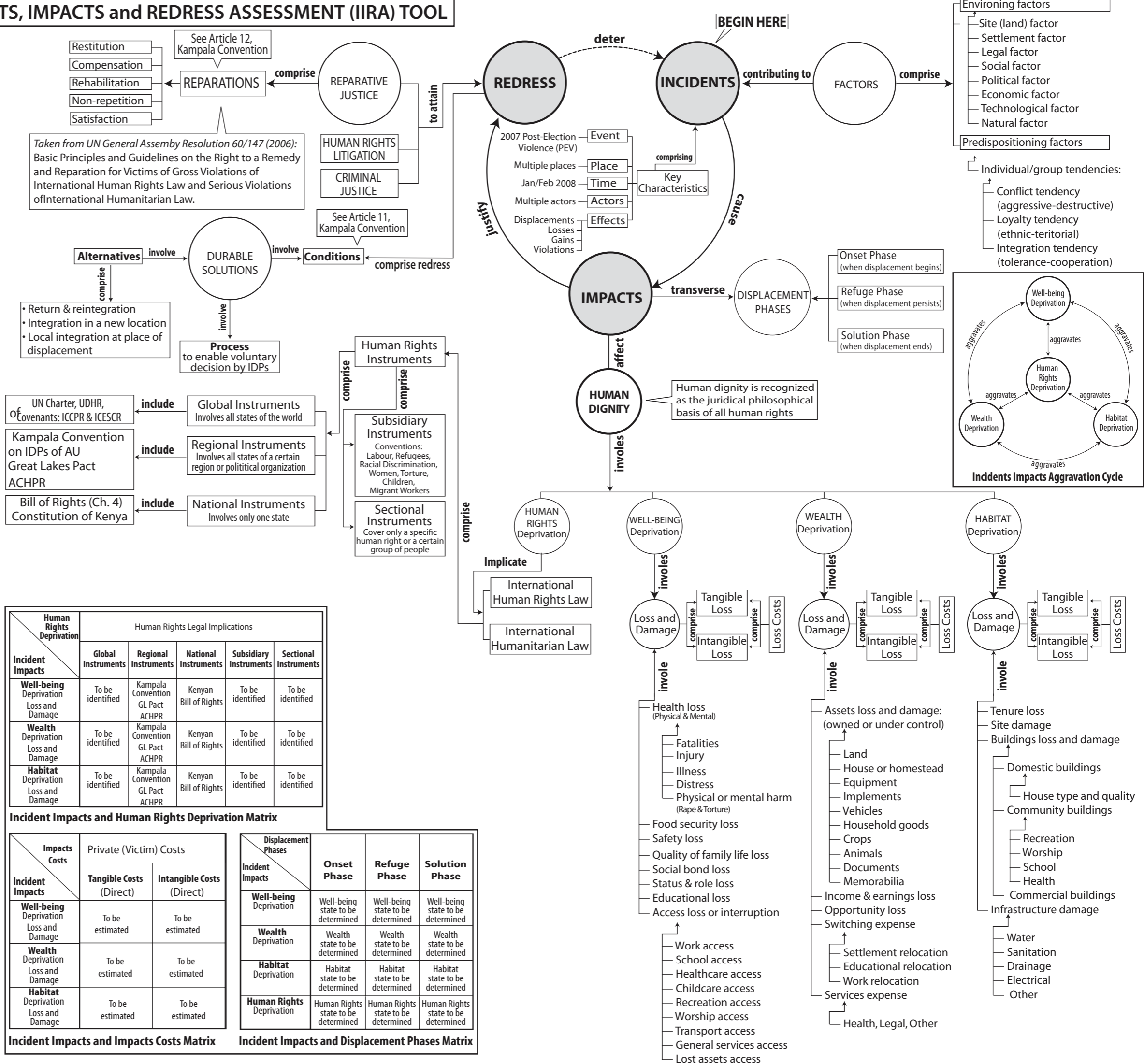


EVICTIIONS and DISPLACEMENTS: INCIDENTS, IMPACTS and REDRESS ASSESSMENT (IIRA) TOOL

IIRA TOOL
 The conceptual structure of the tool is composed of three entities and their elements, and relationships among the entities. They are termed as: **Incidents, Impacts and Redress.**
 The proposition is **Incidents** of involuntary evictions and involuntary displacements of community of inhabitants from their settlements, *cause* heterogenous **Impacts** that *affect* **human dignity**, as they *involve* deprivation of **well-being, wealth and habitat** and **human rights** of the evictees and displacees. The **Impacts** *justify* **Redress** of the wrongdoings, which may *deter* repetition of **Incidents.**
 The chart (a map) displayed is the prose-graphic representation of the tool conceptual structure and proposition.

Evictions and Displacements Project (Kenya)
Basic strategy
 The basic strategy of the project consists of the purpose, the objective to advance it, the output to help to attain the objective and the activities to realize the output.
 The **purpose** is to contribute to the realization of redress of the wrongdoings that affect human dignity, as they involve deprivation of well-being, wealth and habitat and human rights of the community of inhabitants, caused by the impacts of incidents of involuntary evictions and involuntary displacements from their settlements.
 The **objective** is to understand the incidents and to assess the impacts the incidents cause, and the redress the impacts justify.
 The **output** consists of a prototype study of assessment of the impacts and redress of incidents of involuntary evictions and involuntary displacements in Kenya.
 The **activities** include:
 Development of the Incidents, Impacts and Redress Assessment (IIRA) tool.
 Synthesis of diverse methods and techniques for applying the tool.
 Selection of incidents for impacts and redress assessment.
 Production of study relevant information and knowledge.
 Communication of the study products to the users.
 Planning the next course of action.
 The precondition to realize is the external resources and factors, which are necessary to initiate the activities
 The project in Kenya partners with those in Egypt, Cameroon and India, under the umbrella of the Housing and Land Rights Network (HLRN), Habitat International Coalition (HIC).
